The class is a course designed to assist first responders, health care professionals and educators in recognizing bath salts, their effect and signs or symptoms of their use. Lieutenant Tom Reagan is a nationally recognized expert in the area of Bath Salts and has instructed agencies as far away as Seattle Washington. He says it's important to know how to recognize when a person is under the influence of bath salts, and the appropriate way to approach them.

"These are medical emergencies," Reagan said. "They just present themselves as law enforcement issues. These people need medical help more than law intervention."
